β-Catenin

Epitope Specific Rabbit Antibody Catalog #DLN-14083, DLN-14084, or DLN-14085 (0.1ml, 0.5ml, or 1.0ml at 200μg/ml) Catalog #DLN-14087 (7.0ml)

Description: The catenins $(\alpha, \beta \text{ and } \gamma)$ are ubiquitously expressed, cytoplasmic proteins associated with E-cadherin at cellular junctions. β-catenin also binds to N-cadherin and co-immunoprecipitates with APC. Cadherin/catenin complexes are linked to the cytoskeleton via a direct association between α-actinin and α-catenin. Increases tyrosine phosphorylation can disrupt catenin-cadherin complexes, influencing cellular adhesion.

Comments: This antibody is excellent for staining of formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded tissues.

Epitope: C-terminal

Species Reactivity: Human and Mouse. Others not tested.

Immunogen: A synthetic peptide from the C-terminus of the β -catenin protein

Applications and Suggested Dilutions:

- Western Blotting (Ab 2μg/ml for 2 hours at RT)
- Immunopricipitation
- Immunohistology (Formalin/paraffin)

(Ab 1:250 for 10 min at RT)

* [Staining of formalin-fixed tissues REQUIRES boiling tissue sections in 10mM citrate buffer, pH 6.0, for 10-20 min followed by cooling at RT for 20 min.]

The optimal dilution for a specific application should be determined by the investigator.

Positive Control: MCF-7 cells. Breast carcinoma

Cellular Localization: Cytoplasmic and cell membrane

Supplied As:

Affinity purified antibody fraction from rabbit anti-serum. Prepared in 10mM PBS, pH 7.6, with 0.2% BSA and 15mM sodium azide.

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Prediluted antibody which is ready-to-use for immunohistochemical staining.

Storage and Stability:

Store vial at 4°C. When stored at 2-8°C, this antibody is stable for 24 months.





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
