Purity: The antibody was purified from antisera by immunoaffinity chromatography using antigens

coupled to agarose beads.

Antibody Specificity: Based on immunoelectrophoresis and/or ELISA, the antibody reacts with the Fc portion of

human IgG heavy chain but not with the Fab portion of human IgG. No antibody was detected against human IgM or IgA, or against non-immunoglobulin serum proteins. The antibody has been tested by ELISA and/or solid-phase adsorbed to ensure minimal cross-reaction with bovine and mouse serum proteins, but it may cross-react with immunoglobulins from other

species.

Reconstitution and Storage: Store freeze-dried solid at 2-8°C. Rehydrate with 0.75 ml dH2O (exact volume is lot specific)

and centrifuge if not clear. Prepare working dilution on day of use. Product is stable for about 6 weeks at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid. For extended storage after rehydration, aliquot and freeze at -70°C or below. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Alternatively, add an equal volume of glycerol (ACS grade or better) for a final concentration of 50%, and store at -20°C

as a liquid.

Expiration date:one year from date of rehydration. The expiration date may be extended if test

results are acceptable for the intended use.

Safety Information: Standard Laboratory Practices should be followed when handling this material. The chemical,

physical, and toxicological properties of this material have not been thoroughly investigated. The antibody contains 0.05% sodium azide (a poisonous and hazardous substance) as preservative. Although this concentration is not regarded as dangerous to health, appropriate

measures should be taken to avoid skin and eye contact, inhalation, and ingestion.
